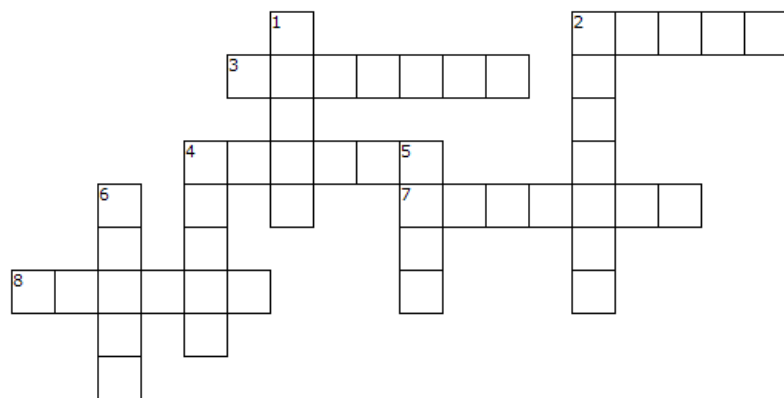
## Jesus Sends Out the Twelve
