The General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM) scholarship **application portal** is open for United Methodist students seeking scholarships for undergraduate and graduate study at colleges, universities and seminaries in the United States. Potential scholarships awarded range from \$500 to \$1,200, on average.

In 2024, GBHEM awarded more than 2,100 scholarships, valued at nearly \$3.7 million, to undergraduate and graduate students at 509 U.S. schools. This financial aid helped students of all backgrounds pursue their dreams and education to serve as the next generation of leaders.

The Scholarships Office administers more than 70 **scholarship programs** with one general application. Students may submit one application per year, which will be screened for the appropriate scholarship program.
